Late applications will not be accepted.

The Friends of the Cary Area Library (FOCAL) are pleased to offer two \$500 scholarships to graduating seniors attending a two or a four-year college or university who reside within the Cary Area Library District. Financial need will be considered, but it will not serve as the primary criteria for selecting scholarship recipients. Successful applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a graduating high school senior (with a 3.0 or above gpa), accepted and planning to attend a two or four-year college or university.
2. Complete and sign this application form.
3. Have assisted the Friends in setting up or working at a book sale, volunteered at the Library or have been a volunteer from the Teen Advisory Board.
4. Respond to two essay questions (minimum 1 paragraph for each question).
5. Provide a short letter of reference from a teacher, a coach, counselor, or dean who is knowledgeable of the applicant's character.
6. Provide a short letter of reference from a non-family member who is knowledgeable of the applicant's character.
7. Live in the Cary Area Public Library District and have a Cary library card.
