- 1. Be a graduating high school senior (with a 3.0 or above gpa), accepted and planning to attend a two or four-year college or university.
- 2. Complete and sign this application form.
- 3. Have assisted the Friends in setting up or working at a book sale, volunteered at the Library and/or have been an active member of the Teen Advisory Board.
- 4. Respond to two essay questions (minimum 1 paragraph for each question).
- 5. Provide a short letter of recommendation from a teacher, a coach, counselor, or dean who is knowledgeable of the applicant's character.
- 6. Provide a short letter of recommendation from a non-family member who is knowledgeable of the applicant's character.
- 7. Live in the Cary Area Public Library District and have a Cary library card.
