Have assisted FOCAL in setting up or working at a book sale, volunteered at the Library and/or have been an active member of the Teen Volunteer Board (TVB).

Respond to your choice of two of the essay questions (minimum one paragraph for each essay).

Provide two short letters of recommendation from a non-family member (supervisor, teacher, coach, counselor, etc) who is knowledgeable of the applicant's character. Letters must be written within three months of the application deadline to meet this criteria.
